2. Hazard Identification

3. Composition / Information on Ingredients

Alkyd/polyurethane resin
Hydrocarbon solvents (mineral turpentine)
Additives and pigments

4. First Aid Measures

Inhalation: Move to fresh air.
Skin Contact: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

Eye Contact: Rinse with water for at least 15 minutes.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention immediately.

5. Fire Fighting Measures

Suitable Media: Water spray, foam, CO₂, dry chemical.

Hazards: Non-flammable under normal conditions.

6. Accidental Release Measures

Contain and absorb with inert material.
Prevent entry into drains.

7. Handling and Storage

Use in well-ventilated areas.
Store in sealed containers between 5–35°C.

8. Exposure Controls / Personal Protection

Ensure adequate ventilation.
Wear gloves, goggles, and protective clothing.

Hydrocarbon solvents: Refer to Safe Work Australia standards

9. Physical and Chemical Properties

Appearance: Coloured liquid
Odour: Solvent
Flash Point: Not applicable
Density: ~0.9–1.1 kg/L
VOC: <450 g/L

10. Stability and Reactivity

Stable under normal conditions.
Avoid heat, sparks, and oxidisers.

11. Toxicological Information

May irritate the skin and eyes.
Prolonged exposure may affect the respiratory system.

12. Ecological Information

Avoid environmental release.
Harmful to aquatic life in large quantities.

13. Disposal Considerations

Dispose of according to local regulations.
Do not pour into drains.

14. Transport Information

Not classified as Dangerous Goods for transport.

15. Regulatory Information

Complies with Safe Work Australia GHS requirements.
