3. Composition / Information on Ingredients

Epoxy resin (Part A)

Amine hardener (Part B)

Additives

4. First Aid Measures

Inhalation: Move to fresh air.

Skin Contact: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

Eye Contact: Rinse cautiously with water

for at least 15 minutes.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention immediately.

5. Fire Fighting Measures

Suitable media: Foam, CO₂, dry chemical.

Hazards: Combustible at high temperatures.

Protective equipment: Self-contained breathing apparatus.

6. Accidental Release Measures

Contain spill.

Absorb with inert material.

Avoid release into drains.

Avoid skin contact.

Store between 5–35°C in sealed containers.

Wear gloves, goggles, and protective clothing.

Use a respirator if ventilation is inadequate.

Appearance: Clear liquid

Odour: Mild

Flash Point: Not applicable

Density: Part A ~1.1 kg/L, Part B ~0.9 kg/L

VOC: Low (<60 g/L)

10. Stability and Reactivity

Stable under normal conditions.

Avoid strong oxidisers.

11. Toxicological Information

May cause skin sensitisation.
Irritating to the eyes and skin.

12. Ecological Information

Avoid environmental release.
May be harmful to aquatic life.

13. Disposal Considerations

Dispose of according to local regulations.
Do not pour into drains.
